Provide Brief Description of Agency's expertise/focus:

PHILLIPS Programs for Children and Families provides educational and supportive services for children with special needs and their families. For over forty years, PHILLIPS has provided a place where children left behind in traditional settings can get the support and education they need to become successful, responsible adults. PHILLIPS Programs serves children and youth with autism; emotional, behavioral and mental disabilities through education, family support services and advocacy. PHILLIPS operates two special education day schools located in Annandale, VA and Laurel, MD. PHILLIPS also operates two community service programs, PHILLIPS Family Partners and PHILLIPS Teaching Homes. PHILLIPS Family Partners is a robust, proactive program designed to help families address behavioral challenges that threaten their ability to keep the child in the home. We take a comprehensive approach to working with the child and family, and our services include case management, family counseling, psychiatric treatment as needed and collaborative goal-setting to address specific family concerns. Services include home-based counseling, in-home respite, mentoring, individual and family therapy, wraparound case management, crisis stabilization, supervised visitation and autism services. PHILLIPS Teaching Homes offers homes with specially trained parents for children with challenging behaviors, learning disabilities, and mental health diagnosis. . Available for children from birth to age 21 at time of placement, our therapeutic foster care program also provides respite care, independent living support, and case management.

Provide Description of Staff Expertise:

PHILLIPS employs staff members with graduate degrees who possess an abundance of experience in working with youth with disabilities. The PHILLIPS staff includes individuals who are licensed as special education teachers, counselors, clinical social workers, speech language pathologists, physical/occupational therapists, and ABA and BCBA licensed staff. Amongst the skills of the staff are a background and training in positive behavioral programming, crisis intervention, implementing technology into curriculum, and data based decision-making.
